On April 4th, 44 Wisconsin school districts chose to go to referendum. Of the referenda questions 61.5% passed.


April 2017 Referendum Breakdown:

- 29 questions asking residents to issue debt totaling \$685,370,000.
- 12 questions asking residents to exceed the revenue limit on a recurring basis in an amount totaling \$17,479,583 per year.
- 24 questions asking residents to exceed the revenue limit on a non-recurring basis in an amount totaling \$261,916,405.


Results:

28 school districts celebrated success:

- 16 Debt question passed totaling \$464,665,000.
- 6 Recurring questions passed totaling \$7,204,747.
- 18 Non-Recurring questions passed totaling \$227,844,405.
