## SUMMARY

On November 7<sup>th</sup>, 8 Wisconsin school districts chose to go to referendum. Of the referenda questions, 70% passed.

### November 2017 Referendum Breakdown:

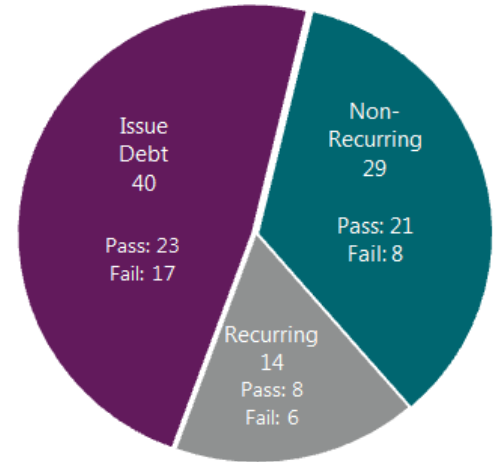
- 6 questions asking residents to issue debt totaling \$167,775,000.
- 4 questions asking residents to exceed the revenue limit on a non-recurring basis in an amount totaling \$25,288,935.

### Results:

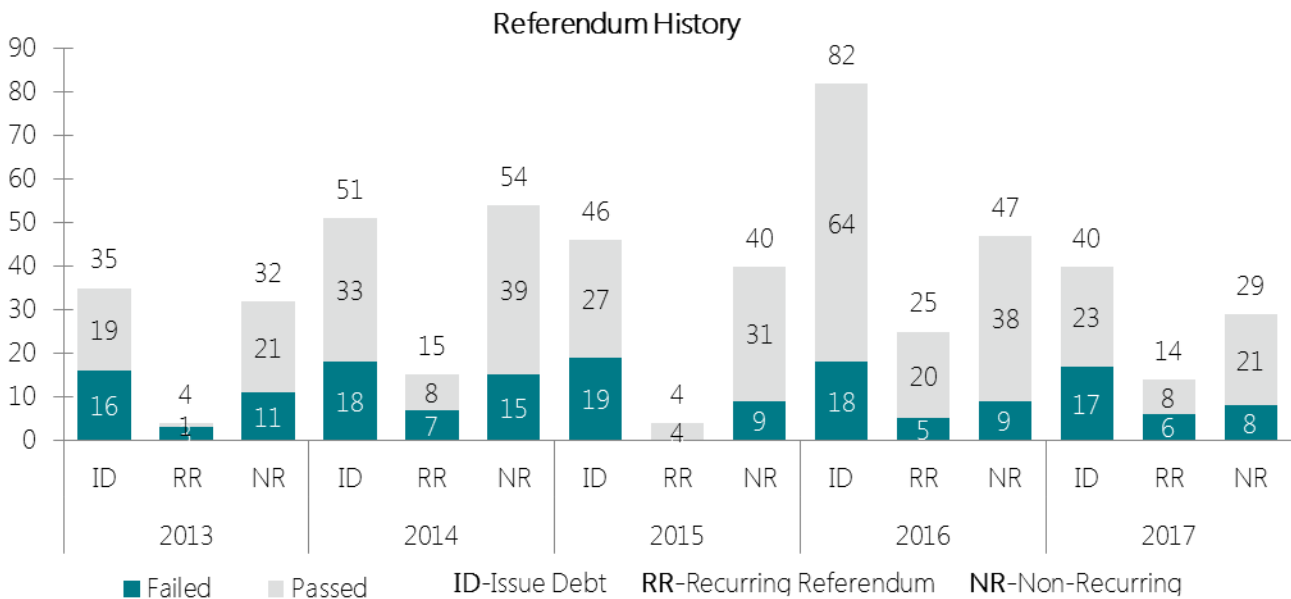
6 school districts celebrated success:

- 4 Debt questions passed totaling \$31,175,000.
- 3 Non-Recurring questions passed totaling \$21,588,935.
