

# REFERENDA RESULTS

NOVEMBER 8, 2016



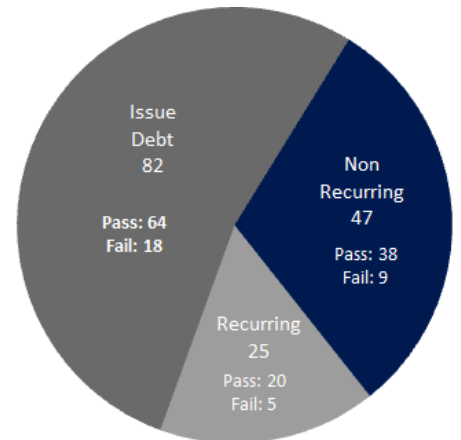
## SUMMARY

On November 8<sup>th</sup>, 47 Wisconsin school districts chose to go to referendum. Of the referenda questions 82% passed.

### November 2016 Referendum Breakdown:

- 42 questions asking residents to issue debt totaling \$1,139,735,000.
- 14 questions asking residents to exceed the revenue limit on a non-recurring basis in an amount totaling \$157,955,000.
- 11 questions asking residents to exceed the revenue limit on a recurring basis in an amount up to \$40,259,000 per year.

### 2016 Referendum Breakdown

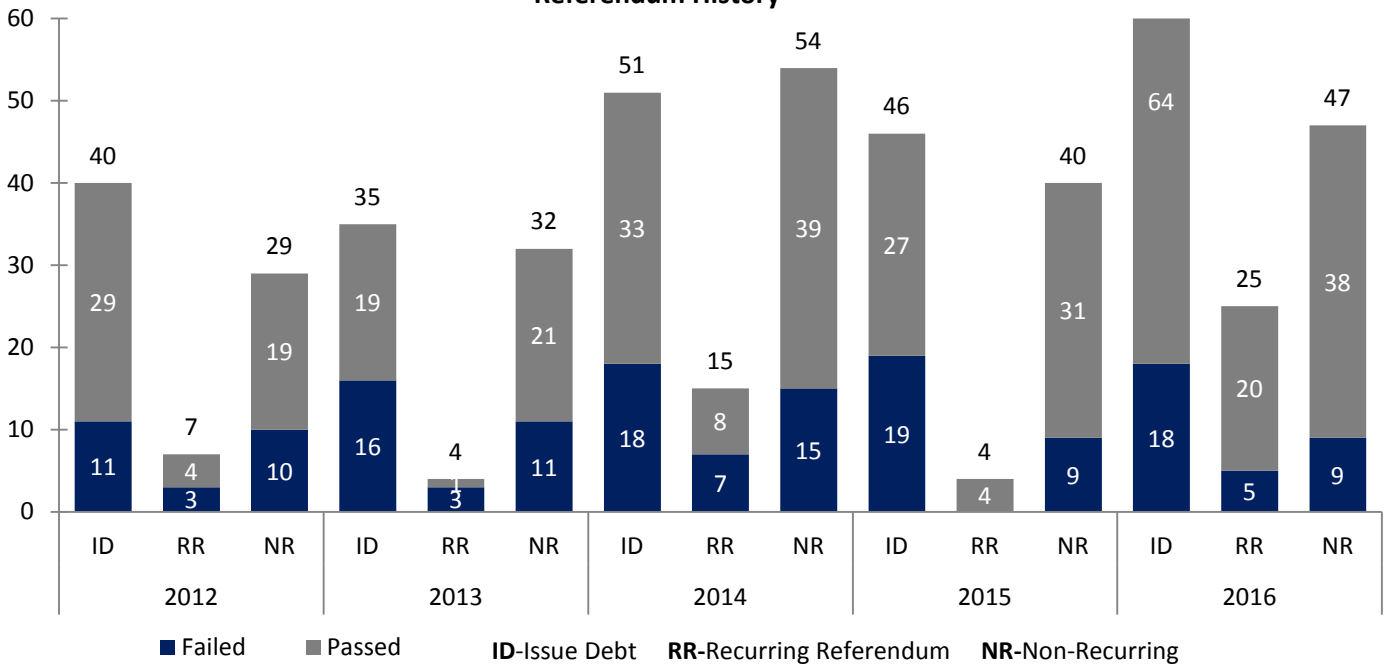


### Results:

42 school districts celebrated success:

- 34 Debt questions passed totaling \$803,835,000.
- 11 Non-recurring questions passed totaling \$143,230,000.
- 10 Recurring questions passed totaling \$40,086,000.
