Top Research

Baird analysts recognized by The Wall Street Journal and Financial Times/StarMine

Baird research analysts have again been recognized among the best in the United States, according to both *The Wall Street Journal* in its annual "Best on the Street" survey of analysts and the *Financial Times/StarMine* in their 11th annual top analyst survey.

In the *Financial Times/StarMine* awards, Baird ranked second overall in terms of the number of awards received. Collectively, *The Wall Street Journal* and *Financial Times/StarMine* surveys recognized 11 Baird research teams with 17 total awards for stock picking and earnings estimate accuracy.

"We firmly believe that our research group is the best in the industry, so we are thrilled that these analysts have been recognized for the quality of their research," said Jon Langenfeld, Director of Research. "I congratulate the analysts and their teams on this honor and thank them for their constant commitment to quality and objectivity."

Two Baird analysts were honored as the "Best on the Street" in this year's survey by The Wall Street Journal, published May 9:

- Will Power ranked No. 1 of 73 analysts in Telecommunications Equipment. William's team includes Steven Beckert, Research Associate; Andrew Flis, Research Analyst; Betty Johnstone and Talitha Hellams, Research Assistants.
- Thomas Russo, ranked No. 2 of 71 analysts in Pharmaceuticals. Thomas's team includes Laura Chico, Research Associate; Ryan Patton, Research Analyst; and Lorna Downing, Research Assistant.

Financial Times/Starmine rankings were based on returns of each analyst's buy/sell recommendations and the accuracy of their earnings estimates for 2011. The top three stock pickers and top three earnings estimators were chosen across 60 industries. All results involved companies based in the United States.

The Wall Street Journal "Best on the Street" survey ranked the top three stock pickers in 44 industries based on their recommendation-performance scores for 2011. Performance scores were calculated based on estimated total return, including price changes and dividends, of each eligible stock an analyst covered in an industry, as well as the number of stocks the analyst covered within that industry.

Baird analysts have been recognized by the *Financial Times/Starmine* since the StarMine awards' inception in 2001.

The Wall Street Journal has recognized Baird research analysts every year since 1993.
