CHICAGO'S TOP SPORTS STARS TO BE HONORED AT ANNUAL EVENT

"27th Annual Comcast SportsNet Sports Awards" presented by Baird and Blue Cross Blue Shield of Illinois televised LIVE on Comcast SportsNet on Wednesday, March 4th at 7:30 PM CT

CHICAGO, Feb. 25, 2015 – Many of Chicago's most popular professional athletes will take center stage to receive honors at the "27th Annual Comcast SportsNet Sports Awards" presented by Baird and Blue Cross Blue Shield benefiting the March of Dimes.

This year's honorees include: **PAUL KONERKO** (legendary White Sox captain, who helped lead the team to its first World Series title in 88 years), **MIKE DUNLEAVY** (veteran NBA standout whose on-court/off-court contributions have paid significant dividends for the Bulls), **BRYAN BICKELL** (gritty left winger for the Blackhawks who was a key contributor to the team's Stanley Cup title in 2013), **KYLE LONG** (starting right guard for the Bears who earned Pro Bowl honors in each of his first two NFL seasons), **HARRY SHIPP** (Chicago Fire midfielder and Lake Forest, IL, native who helped lead Notre Dame to the 2013 NCAA championship, runner-up for MLS "Rookie of the Year").

For the pinnacle moment of the evening, this year's **March of Dimes "Inspirational Athlete" award winner is 16-yearold Northlake, IL resident/USA Sled Hockey Gold Medalist BRODY ROYBAL from West Leyden H.S.** Brody has persevered as a standout athlete, student and ambassador, despite being born with a birth defect. The evening is also scheduled to include a special tribute to multiple "Sports Awards" honoree and one of Chicago's greatest superstars, the late **Ernie Banks** (1931-2015).

Attendees at this year's 27th Annual Comcast SportsNet Sports Awards can also participate in a silent auction featuring Chicago sports packages and more to support the March of Dimes mission for stronger, healthier babies.
