NOVEMBER 6, 2018

On November 6th, 61 Wisconsin school districts chose to go to referendum for a total of 82 questions. 93% of school district referendum questions were approved, making 2018 the highest approval rate (89%) since the revenue limit formula was implemented.

NOVEMBER 2018 REFERENDUM BREAKDOWN:

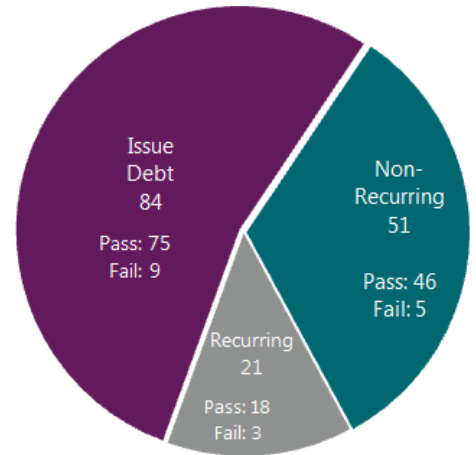
- 44 questions asking residents to issue debt totaling \$1,249,145,000.
- 24 questions asking residents to exceed the revenue limit on a non-recurring basis in an amount totaling \$157,026,073.
- 14 questions asking residents to exceed the revenue limit on a recurring basis in an amount totaling \$26,133,487.

RESULTS:

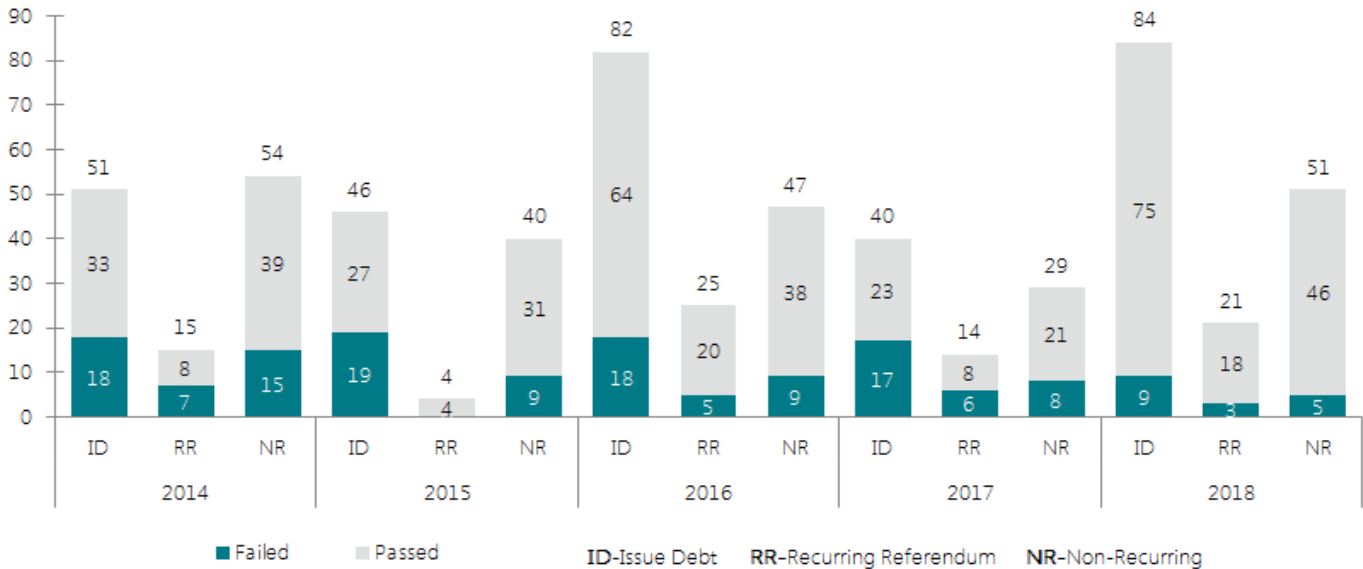
57 school districts celebrated success:

- 42 Debt questions passed totaling \$1,207,905,000
- 21 Non-Recurring questions passed totaling \$140,591,073
- 13 Recurring questions passed totaling \$24,015,000
